- 2 Individuals/groups must provide their own music and **group name and performer list must accompany entry.**
- 3 Must have Scottish/Celtic music and Scottish/Celtic theme.
- 4 Costumes must follow the theme and content.
- 5 Total performance time (including walk on and walk off music) must not exceed 5 minutes or you will be disqualified (includes set-up and removal of props).
